## About The Ride

The Routes - This year the Bike Ride for Amy will offer three bike routes:

15-mile ride - includes unpaved roadway and requires a hybrid bike.

25-mile ride - designed for individuals who ride for pleasure and prefer to progress at their own pace.

50-mile ride - designed for more experienced and trained riders who are in good physical condition. The longer route is a combination of flat, rolling, and hilly terrain.



All riders will enjoy the beauty of the landscape in Somerset County, while helping to raise funds to support the cost of screening mammograms for uninsured women.


The 15, 25 & 50 mile Bike Ride for Amy begins at 8:00 am at South Brunswick Community Center 124 New Road, Monmouth Junction, NJ. 08824

All riders will be provided with a water bottle, a Bike Ride for Amy t-shirt, and a biker's 'bib' to wear on the ride. A SAG group will follow the riders; beverages and snacks will be provided at the start of the ride as well as at a rest stop along the bike route.

## The Amy Foundation Bike Ride Waiver 2010

I understand that The Amy Foundation Bike Ride 2010 ("Event") will be ridden on public roads and private property without specific oversight by any public safety authorities, and that biking in this manner is an inherently dangerous activity. I acknowledge that I am voluntarily participating in the Event and, further, that participating in the Event could result in severe injury, disablement, or death. Throughout my participation in the Event, I voluntarily, explicitly and fully assume all the risks of damage to my property, direct or indirect injury of any kind to my person, no matter how severe, disablement, or death (a "casualty") that impacts me due to my actions or the actions or inactions of The Amy Foundation or its volunteers, including the Sponsors, Promoters and Managers of the Event, their employees or agents, or any other participant in the Event (collectively "The Amy Foundation of its volunteers") whether or not the action by The Amy Foundation or its volunteers could be considered negligent.

I indemnify and hold The Amy Foundation and its volunteers harmless against loss, cost or damage to me arising from casualty during my participation in the Event, whether from collision with any fixed object or structure, pedestrian, vehicle, other participant, or due to equipment failure, inadequate safety warnings, or precautions, weather conditions, or otherwise, and I shall have no cause of action in tort or other claim against The Amy Foundation or its volunteers arising out of participation in the Event. This indemnification shall bind my personal representative and my heirs and no successor to me shall have any claim, nor be able to maintain any cause of action in tort or other claim against The Amy Foundation or its volunteers, individually or collectively, arising out of my participation in the Event.

I state and attest that I have the requisite level of physical fitness to safely participate in the Event. To my knowledge, I have no medical condition that would result in a casualty from my participation in the Event. I will provide evidence of my health insurance coverage and health insurance identification card upon request of The Amy Foundation or its volunteers. If I am injured and unable to seek or authorize emergency medical care I hereby authorize The Amy Foundation or its volunteers to obtain such care at my expense.

I agree to wear head protection gear and will use no type of head phone at any time while bike mounted. I am responsible for providing a satisfactory bicycle and all repair tools and spare parts necessary to keep my bicycle in operating condition.

To avoid removal from the Event, I will abide by the general rules of the Event and any specific instructions given to me by The Amy Foundation or its volunteers that it deems necessary for the safe conduct of the Event.

I cannot unilaterally modify this indemnification or my obligations hereunder in any manner. My obligations hereunder shall survive my participation on the Event.
